Assurance Review of the operation of the Accredited Employer Work Visa Scheme

Engagement with interested parties external to the Ministry of Business, Innovation and Employment (MBIE)

Introduction

- As set out in the terms of reference for this Assurance Review, Public Service Commissioner Mr Peter Hughes has appointed the Reviewer, Jenn Bestwick, to independently review the operation of the Accredited Employer Work Visa (AEWV) Scheme.
- 2. This minute sets out the process for interested parties external to MBIE to engage with the Review.

Focus of this independent assurance review

- 3. The purpose of this review is to consider whether Immigration New Zealand is administering the AEWV scheme appropriately, and to identify any areas for improvement with a focus on mitigating the risk of migrant exploitation and irregular migration. It was initiated to provide independent assurance as to the operation of the scheme.
- 4. Complaints about specific cases or the conduct of individuals are relevant insofar as they may illustrate wider issues of process. However, the resolution of such complaints is outside of scope and will not be addressed through this Review and should be addressed to alternative processes currently underway within MBIE.
